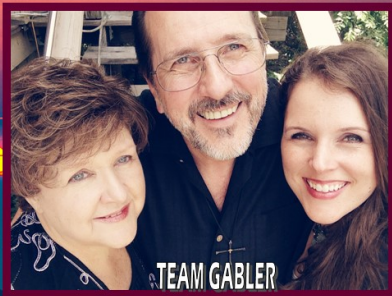

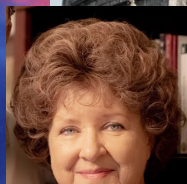

Two Dreams, Two Battles, Two Victories

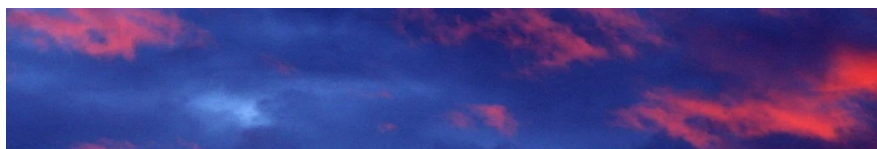

Dreams can seem random or strange and still carry Holy Spirit revelation and insights that equip us for purpose. If we are impacted by an unusual or troubling dream, often we can get the gist of it's meaning even without a full interpretation, like the call to intercession in the first dream below. Sometimes we can see why we dreamed because parts of it are what's going on in real life or because parts of it have been on our mind recently. However, sometimes dreams seem far fetched with no logical ties to real life. In those dreams, understanding can come through key symbols when they open to us, like the wall and the color white in the following dream.

The Faux Fortress: A dreamer we know dreamed that he went to visit a woman who had built a white house, somewhat like a castle with a big white wall around it that kept out all comers. Wanting to check on her, he managed to get inside the wall, but a friend of hers was standing guard to alert her of intruders. As he got inside the house, (also white in color), the owner (dressed in white) ran up two flights of stairs to avoid him. When he awoke from the dream, he did not have an immediate interpretation or full understanding but he was troubled by it because he was concerned about this fam-



ily member. So the dream became a prompt to pray for the lady, and intercession was the first layer of purpose for the dream.

It was many months later that this strange dream opened further to reveal crucial insights behind the call to intercession for the lady in white. Though the dreamer had not realized it at first, a key message in this dream was that the woman was not open to help or input from anyone. Her guard inside the wall was a second witness to the fact that she did not intend to allow anyone to reach her. The way the dreamer was able to get through the protective wall outside the house was the key to understanding the dream. When his head had hit the outside wall, his teeth sunk into it. That revealed to him that the wall was made from Styrofoam, so he then tore through it to get to the house. Most often a house symbolizes a person or family. This elaborate white house was the self-image she had built to dwell in. It was white because she wanted her conclusions and decisions to be viewed as pure and holy and justifiable. However, she had built a facade, a faux fortress, that really was not the strength and purity and protection that she longed for. It was a great effort of self-justification rather than real justification as a gift from God. The blockage to her receiving God's gift was that she wanted to be justified without letting go of resentment and bitterness and fear that she had gathered through her years of suffering injustice. Having literally been abandoned and betrayed several times since childhood, the hurt and injustice was undeniable; so she sought to purify her resentment and use her anger to protect herself from any more injustice. Anger can be a powerful front to hide weakness or insecurities or vulnerabilities but a victim, whether they appear pitiful or powerful, continues to live with a victim heart until they overcome the pain and the threat of pain. Her efforts had hidden her victim heart from many people, but her elaborate efforts did not get her to Peace from the Prince of Peace. Submitting our life to be governed by the Prince of Peace involves releasing the past through FORGIVENESS and embracing the future through TRUST in Him.

The unusual dream revealed what logic could not reveal to the concerned dreamer. This lady was a wife, mother, grandmother and business woman who had served God and been active in the Church for years. Logic did not explain how she literally began to host a

demonic force that visibly tormented her in her last few years. Yet, the faux fortress revealed in the dream, showed that she could not protect herself from the enemy that had access to her because of her bitterness. Was her salvation voided by such an enemy? No. What can separate us from the love of God and His covenant? Did her early death mean intercession had failed? No. Her demise came with the fall of her faux fortress that was built by human efforts. Intercession in her behalf lives on as agreement with the redemption of her legacy where God's love and faithfulness are still active in her behalf.

A Patriarch's Call to War: Another friend had a strange dream that was short but impacting. He had a flashlight and was walking into darkness situated between freestanding cement walls. In the deep darkness, something grabbed his arm and he yelled himself awake.

This dreamer is the patriarch of four living generations as well as a spiritual father in the Body of Christ. The first obvious thing about the walls was that they were causing division in his domain. The intent of division is to cause a fall or defeat in lives and relationships. The free standing walls were certainly a set up for a house divided to fall and somebody would get hurt if that happened. The walls were not only a divisive threat in his sphere of responsibility, they were also blockages that kept light (understanding and truth) out of the thick darkness between them. Taking a flashlight, he searched the shadows formed by the cement blockages. Before he could find answers, he encountered something inhabiting and taking advantage of the darkness. The foe within the darkness evidently wanted his hiding place left untouched so he tried to protect his hiding place by intimidating the dreamer and grabbing his arm.

That kind of sudden wake up from the dream indicated it was not merely a dream but an interactive experience between realms. It was revelation to this patriarch and he awoke with an awareness of blockages and divisive tactics that needed to be dismantled. It could be a process to get to a full understanding of what was blocking and causing division in the lives within his reach but the first step was, and always is, prayer and asking for wisdom.

At first the implications were that if the patriarch could not see the culprit and identify him, then there would be no confrontation

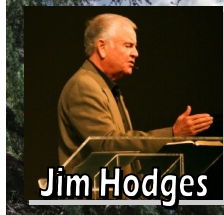
able to interrupt his dark agenda. That thinking loomed like an unspoken threat from the dream experience. However, the adversary could not hide from the Holy Spirit who was anointing this patriarch to watch over his sphere of responsibility. The adversary thought he had the win due to the fact that the man had not had enough light or revelation to expose him in that first encounter that night. Since the man seemed shaken and had not been able to see how the power of darkness was operating right there in his reach, the presumptuous devil thought he could not be defeated and left a gloating echo in its wake.

HOWEVER, waking up from a dream like that was THE wake up point, and a call to arms! Instruction from the Word is to agree with your adversary quickly, I believe that is because the basis of his taunts is always you and your frailties so that you feel unqualified to defeat him. And he doubles down to pick a setting to try to isolate you so that you feel alone and lacking, but you are never the Lone Ranger (and by the way, the enemy won't even mention Tonto when he is isolating you in his cross-hairs). The equipping truth is that the Lone Ranger and Tonto are fictional, but sons of God are real and never alone (and do not have to be perfect to prevail).

The patriarch's search and conquer began. He took note of things going on in his world like physical sickness, strained relationships and conflicts in mind and emotions. Was it fear or accusation or offense or unforgiveness causing blockages that made a place for darkness to hide destructive agendas and whispered curses? His father's heart was stirred to identify and defeat the forces of darkness working against he and his reach. The abrupt wake-up from his dream was also a key timing signal . . . for it was time to war and win!

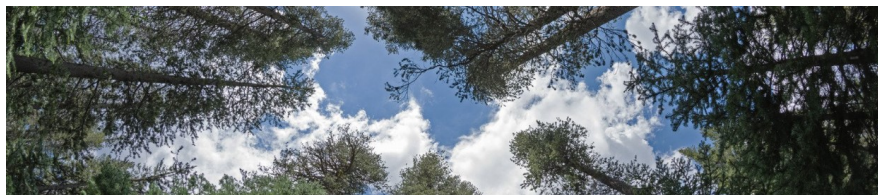

Our Vertical Perspective



I heard a pastor say, “We’re preparing not only for a battle, we’re preparing for victory.” We’ve been fighting a lot of battles lately. We’re fighting the battle between globalism and nationhood. We have globalists who want to rule the world and run the world by anti-God principles. So we’re battling this whole thing way back in Genesis. God says, I’ll bless all nations through Abraham’s seed, which is Christ. But of course, you know what happened and still does. Instead of nations being blessed, they gather and centralize governmentally and bureaucratically. In real life that boils down to the elites taking control and telling people how to live their life. That lack of freedom is tyranny. That battle is going on right now in our nation. It’s one of the reasons we’re having conflict politically. We have globalists in America and they are anti-nationhood. We’re warring a battle culturally.

I never thought I’d ever live long enough to see what’s happening in our nation’s culture: the depths of depravity, bizarre behavior and absolutely deranged public policy. We’re in a political war because there are anti-American forces in both parties. A Spirit-baptized believer must pull out the party platforms and not blindly vote for a man or a party. People say the church is too political, but we’re not political enough. Jesus rules over every inch of creation, every nation, so we have to be involved on every level spiritually, then culturally and politically. So the war that’s



going on is more internal, and it's determinative of how we'll fight other wars, specifically the war between the vertical perspective and the horizontal perspective.

Keeping a vertical perspective is the great battle. In Psalm 2 we're given a scenario historically and prophetically but also contemporaneously about where we are. The Psalm starts off by asking the question, "Why are the nations in an uproar and the kings of the earth?" Those are civil leaders, judges and kings of the earth. Why are they in a rage, taking counsel against the Lord and against His anointed? There are antichrist forces today taking a stand against the authority of our God, against the authority of our nation's founding biblical, Judeo-Christian worldview. So where we are right now is in a time of rage. Marxists, socialists, rioters, looters or whomever are part of the rage. We all decry injustice and racism, while the ragers buy into the antichrist deception. In this atmosphere of rage on our streets and television screens, it is sometimes difficult to keep our perspective and priorities looking out horizontally. You and I as God's people must actually have the view of both perspectives.

Keeping the horizontal perspective informed by their vertical perspective is what the prophets did. Isaiah chapter one, the prophet describes the horizontal perspective. He says, the nation is weighed down by its sins, iniquity and acting corruptly, even despising the holy one of Israel. How discouraging that chapter begins, but all of a sudden whiplash. Here comes chapter two and the prophet sees the nations everywhere streaming up the mountain of God to learn of His ways to walk in His paths. What a transition from horizontal to vertical perspective! We have to make sure the vertical perspective is the priority. The Lord says, *the peoples are devising a vain thing* or empty thing. Those who rage are giving themselves to a vain, empty cause. Think about that. They seem to have some success moving forward in their agenda, but they have ultimately and finally given themselves to something that fails.

Thankfully, as God's people we're not giving ourselves to an empty cause. We're giving ourselves to the cause of the fullness of Christ in the church. The body of Him who gave Himself for us is being active in the nation, being active in the culture, being active in every sphere of life. We call these spheres the seven mountains of culture today, referring to media, arts and entertainment, education, family, religion, business and government. So we've got to keep this in mind: Though the wicked may prosper for a while, just like Hitler did in Germany in World War II, the day came when he was dealt with. The evil may not be destroyed overnight, but it has given itself to an empty cause and it is destined for failure. Now, where we are (I think) in America, is that the body of Christ has got to do a better job of speaking out about what's going on. In Hit-

lers's day, the Church essentially just opened the door for Hitler to come in. Only a remnant, Dietrich Bonhoeffer and pastor Martin Nemo spoke up to expose the agenda. The Church doesn't just pray for stuff to happen, we pray against wrong agendas. We can bind and loose. We can take authority because we've been given delegated authority by the Lord Himself.

Knowing that all media, to some degree, will skew the horizontal perspective, I went on a fast of all my news websites for two weeks. I felt better. Then I decided to just go to Christian websites, but I still didn't get encouraged enough. The Church cannot be distressing. A major university in the Christian world said that we're not condemning, just observing. We listen because this is real combat. This is real war in the spirit. And things are going to shift like they do in verse four of Psalm 2: *Why have the nations raged and the peoples are meditating on vanity? Psalms 2:2 The kings of the earth set themselves; yea, the rulers have plotted together against Jehovah and His Anointed, saying, Psalms 2:3 We will break their bands in two, and throw off their cords from us. Psalms 2:4 He who sits in the heavens shall laugh; the Lord shall mock at them. Psalms 2:5 Then He will speak to them in His anger, and He will terrify them in His wrath;* The first three verses are really a horizontal perspective, but in verse four, things go vertical. We have to keep our perspective where it needs to be. Jesus is at the right hand of the Father. *Colossians 3:1 If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God. Colossians 3:2 Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth.* We've got to know what's going on in the horizontal level but focus vertically. In Revelation 4, the Lord said to John, come up here (vertical) and I'll show you things that must take place.

Worshiping the Lord, the Lamb, will access the vertical perspective for the church, and that'll enable us to view the horizontal perspective with more accuracy and victory. Worship of our Lord enhances everything. When the Church worships the Lamb, God enhances our intercession, enhances our outreach and enhances all we do. Worshiping the Lamb helps us to engage the culture to disciple nations. How interesting, Psalm 2 wraps up with a challenge demanding a response from the kings and judges of the earth. King James here says "kiss the Son" because the kiss was a sign of covenant friendship. So there's the response demanded, a covenant friendship with the highest level of authority in the civil realm and all other realms.

Every name that's named in the universe has to fall and bow before the authority of Jesus (Eph.1:21), and that's the pivot of the vertical perspective.

We just finished our youth camp in Texas. It was absolutely amazing! We gathered with twenty-two churches from all over Texas and one that flew in from Michigan. All together we had 400 kids and 175 adults. The days were filled with team activities, devotionals, quiet time, games, free time activities, and evening chapels that were so powerful. It takes a year of planning, organizing, training, purchasing, traveling, and connecting to put on this event. Young people gave their hearts to the Lord. So many were healed physically. Kids were delivered from a spirit of suicide, porn, self-loathing, anxiety, abandonment and trauma. Campers were activated to lay hands on the sick and saw their friends healed. So many answered the call to missions, the church, marketplace, government, education, arts and entertainment, business and finance. We baptized 70 young people in the camp pool, releasing them to walk in a new life in Christ.

The prayer covering before, during and after was essential to what God wanted to do. The whole camp was at another level. You could feel the prayers had brought an open heaven over that facility, and the Holy Spirit was there to flow as He saw fit. The level of agreement was amazing. We had all of us, staff, counselors, camp-



ers and facility staff all loving in the same direction. The weather was a true miracle. The week before the forecast was 80-90% rain every day. We did not ask God to move the whole storm, rather just to keep it clear over the camp. 100 acres ain't nothing for the good Lord! And that is exactly what He did. The radar picture is what happened every day. It would rain a bit, open up around us, and bring in nice and cool weather in the 70's which is a total miracle for East Texas in June! Truly, God has been good to us.



I was sitting with our drummer up in the sound booth. He had not been to camp in several years. He was amazed at the five different screens that controlled the sound, the lighting, the livestream, editing, the recording, the video projection, and the five people it took to run everything. He was blown away at how we had grown to another level. What I saw wasn't just the technology that we had grown into, but who we have become. I pointed to each of the tech crew members and identified where each had come from...Willis, Lake Jackson, Palestine, Magnolia, and Bellville. We did the same thing with the worship team, all coming from different churches and regions to offer their gift. No one cares who gets the glory but Jesus. An amazing thing happened on Tuesday night in Chapel. Prophet Marty Gabler had several words of knowledge. One of the words was about a young lady who got a report that she could never have children. Another word was that someone was thinking about running away from home. Well, lo and behold, the next day we heard back from one church that a fifteen year old young lady had gone to the doctor the week before camp and was informed that because of her condition she would not be able to have children. What a devastating word for someone who is just fifteen years old. She laid hold of that word and the promise of God and was encouraged about the future. That in itself is amazing, but there is more! We have a staff meeting at the end of the evening to plan for the next day. One of the youth leaders from another church stood up and

testified that she had been told that she could never have children. She said that she took hold of that word from Marty and believed God for herself. She hadn't cycled in two years, but the next morning her cycle started! As all the staff began to shout and praise God, I heard something in my spirit, "The body was designed to heal itself." What??? I've heard that in the natural, but now in the body of Christ! Ephesians 4:16 gives us insight, "From whom the whole body fitly joined together and compacted by that which every joint supplieth, according to the effectual working in the measure of every part, maketh increase of the body unto the edifying of itself in love." When the body of Christ comes together in "one accord" like Acts 2, accord is "*homothumadon*" which is one mind or one passion. Also, where two agree on anything, agree is "*sumphoneo*," which is to be in harmony. The life giving flow in which every joint supplies and the body edifies itself in love tells me that God designed His body to allow the healing flow of love to meet the needs of each other.

A young lady in our church was struck by a debilitating disease that had made her life miserable for eight years. She could hardly walk, couldn't work, drive, nor could she be in sunlight or around loud noises. She decided to go to camp last year and began a process of walking in healing. God began to show her generational issues needing to be dealt with and she returned again this year. She is an intercessor and part of our prayer team. She made it the whole week and wanted to be baptized into the new season. Sunday morning after camp, she is up front dancing before the Lord. Praise God!

We set aside time to do prophetic ministry with youth pastors in the afternoon. So many of them come in so beat down, not just by "the work" or the world, but by leadership and the church. They came in dealing with church splits or carrying the guilt of an unfaithful pastor or attacks by leaders using so-called "gifts of the spirit" to bring accusation and condemnation against them, or dealing with the heavy weight of generational strongholds limiting their walk and relationships. We saw the prophetic word bring new life into their eyes and hearts. They found friendship and support from the other pastors at camp and new bonds of encouragement were formed. Perhaps 1 Corinthians 11:29 is not just about taking communion, but about discerning the Lord's body as a whole. Maybe this is why so many are "weak and sick" among us. When we get to the place of loving the body and allowing the body of Christ to love one another, then nothing is impossible.

In the Bible, the word shadow is mentioned seventy-two times. This number has great significance in scripture and deep meaning when connected with the Father's plans for heavenizing His earth. The word, "shadow" is found in 72 verses of the Bible in Old and New Testaments combined. This number represents unity, redemption, gospel-spreading, and spiritual leadership.

"Shadow" can be a reference to protection and refuge. It symbolizes Father's protective presence and safety for those who are under His care. Psalm 91:1 states, *He that dwells in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the SHADOW of the Almighty.* Here, the presence of God is spoken of not as a PLACE of refuge, but a PERSON of refuge. Most High God speaks of the supremacy that He IS! Within this passage is an invitation for us to come out of the shadows of evil, religion, self-promotion, or dead works and into a divine relationship with Father God, The Shadow. As David approached his encounter with Goliath, he declared, Yea though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil; for YOU are WITH ME...(Psalm 23:4). While others were hiding in the shadows of terror from the curses of the giant, David came out of that shadow of fear and into The Shadow of faith in the Most High God! He was convinced that God was IN HIM and FOR HIM, and that victory was His!

The word "shadow" can also represent the fleeting nature of hu-

man life. It is a reminder that our time on earth is brief by comparison to eternity. Life is too short to live in the shadows of sin, irrelevance, religious bondage, sickness and disease, or in bondage to others who would seek to lord over our lives. James 4:14 declares, *Whereas you know not what shall be on the morrow. For what is your life? It is even a vapor that appears for a little time and then vanishes away.* Life is too precious; we must abide IN The Shadow and thus follow His direction and directives to make certain that our lives count for His Kingdom.

That said, The Shadow (Father God) is also our source of guidance through our life's journey. This is illustrated in Exodus 13:21 where the Lord led Moses and the children of Israel to the Promised Land by directing their walk in a pillar of cloud by day and pillar of fire by night. God's children had come out of the shadows of slavery and begin their journey to destiny. In order to stay on course, they were instructed to follow the cloud that provided peace (shade) and guidance by day and the pillar of fire (guidance and protection) by night. Moses would also be summoned by God to meet with Him in the cloud (His presence) where He would speak face to face with The Shadow.

Shadow is also used in describing the darkness, difficulty, and death structures associated with religious rituals and legalism. The valley of the shadow of death (Psalm 23:4) is a description of the darkness (shadow) present in the earth through Satan, the god of this world (2 Corinthians 4:4). As long as we walk this planet, Satan's darkness will lurk in the shadows of our culture. We are blessed by the Father in that we do not dwell IN the valley of that shadow but rather WALK TROUGH the valley as victors over deception and death by aligning our hearts and souls with The Shadow, The Father Himself! James declares that in Christ, Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and comes down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither SHADOW OF TURNING. Through Christ, Father keeps us in the greater Shadow, HIM!

There is no question that in our nation, shadow government (cryptocracy) has existed for many years and become especially exposed in the past year. This means that those in positions of power are controlled by other powers behind the scenes, or in the shadows. This is how Satan operates to maneuver and manipulate individuals

and cultures to do his bidding. He lurks in the shadows and draws those to walk with him and serve his evil purposes.

The Father is removing the veil from the shadows. He is reaching out to us who love and follow Him, and He is drawing mankind once again to His acceptance and peace through His genuine heart of fatherhood. He is delivering mankind from the shadows of sin, deception, control, religion, and eternal death. The wars that rage within and around us are intensifying because grace is being extended in an unprecedented way. The shadow of darkness is becoming confronted by the outpouring of Holy Spirit, signs and wonders, and Great Awakening. This awakening and revival that is manifesting is drawing multitudes from the shadows of darkness and placing them into the heart and life of The Shadow! The lost are coming to Christ in multitudes. The body of Christ is coming face to face with their own shadow lives and being purged by Holy Spirit fire. Sin, death structures, fear, narcissism, hopelessness, condemnation and more are being swallowed up by the love of The Father and His desire for all to abide under The Shadow, Himself.

The Father is healing His Church and establishing the standard by which we all shall follow. Evil has come to the place of critical mass; and while The Father judges evil with firm judgment, he simultaneously judges His sons and daughters with mercy and grace. He is not a Father who desires to destroy His offspring but rather The Father who desires to love and restore us! He draws all mankind to come near to Him and abide In Him, The Shadow.

In Luke 10, Jesus commissioned the 70 to go in 2's (72) to the cities where He would be ministering. He declared to them that, the harvest is truly great, but the laborers are few (verse 2). They were tasked with demonstrating the Kingdom of God by healing the sick. The disciples were sent to illuminate the hearts of men that Jesus was indeed Messiah who had been sent by the Father to establish His kingdom in the hearts of all mankind.

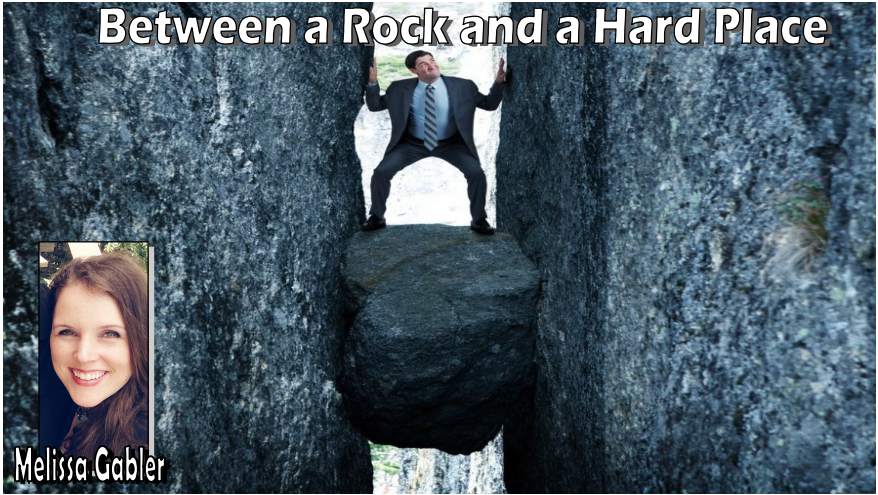

heart-sick place. Now, I'm not talking about wanting to give up on God and run the other way. That's not even an option. I'm talking about feeling terminally stuck in that abyss between hard places. So, there really was relief when I realized that I got myself in this situation and God did not exile me here.

I think that is where our nation is at the moment... a heart-sick place. There was so much hope in the presidential election that a Christian might get in. Not only did that not happen, but the hope stirred on the other end of the issues seems to be waning with each passing decision. And in the church realm there have been shifts and decisions that have unnerved the hopeful. So, there is somewhat of a heart-sick plague going around. I don't know about you, but it always makes me feel better when I realize it's not just me feeling the pressure. It's something much bigger than an individual.

So, what is the strategy? We have to put our hope in the Truth. 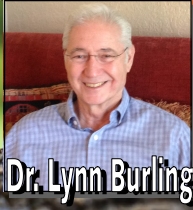
"Be strong and let your heart take courage, all you who wait for and hope for and expect the Lord!" (Ps. 31:24)

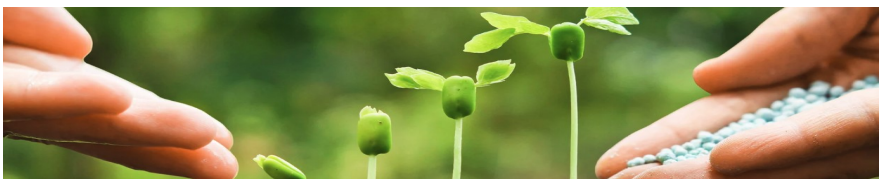
Don't "Hybridize" Your Seed and Become Fruitless



When we violate the design of God, we end up with “mixed” seed that, 1) either doesn’t bear any fruit, or 2) doesn’t bear any fruit that is capable of reproducing. Leviticus 19:19 “You shall not let your cattle breed with different kind. You shall not sow your field with two kinds of seed.”

I am going to use illustrations to reinforce the believers to be fruitful, bearing fruit for the kingdom, some “souls” and some “good deeds”. Mt 7:16 says, “You shall know them by their fruits.” Verse 17 says “Every healthy tree bears good fruits,”; and vs 19 says, “Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire.” I’m referring to a difference between the secular and the sacred. How do we live in a secular world and still remain fruitful, fulfilling our sacred callings? Someone said, “The water floats the ship, but when the water gets into the ship, it’s original design has been breached and its effectiveness is marginalized.

If you take a horse and breed it with a donkey, you end up with a mule. A mule cannot reproduce. It is sterile, seedless! Science has now produced seedless melons and other seedless fruits such as



lemons and oranges. They lack the full nutritional profile of vitamins, minerals and fiber. Also, they can be less resistant to pests and diseases, i.e., the devil and his wiles. So, mixing seed produces hybrids that can look the same but lack the benefits of their original design and purpose.

In John 15:1-8, Jesus gives us an overview of what a successful believer should be and lets us know the good and bad consequences of our relationship with Him. This is a contraction of these verses from each key word or phrase: “I am the Vine, every branch in me that does not bear fruit, is taken away; every branch that bears is pruned that it may bear more fruit. Abide in me. You cannot bear fruit by yourself, It must abide in the vine, Whoever abides in me and I in him, will bear much fruit. Apart from me, you can do nothing. If you abide in me and my words abide in you, ask whatever you wish and it will be done for you.” Lastly, vs 8, “By this, my Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit and so prove to be my disciples.”

You cannot discover your significance in Christ until you first discover your insignificance without Him. God puts us on a journey of maturity because immature hearts mishandle holy assignments, i.e., secular and sacred. Holiness and spiritual fruitfulness are deeply intertwined. Mixing or cross-breeding with the secular can blunt or destroy our fruitfulness. Simply put, HOLINESS is what God is, and GLORY is how he shows it. Intimacy with God fosters holiness, which in turn fosters more intimacy, which bears more fruit. Fruitfulness is not a passive outcome of faith, bearing fruit is the evidence of a transformed life. God promised Abram and Sarai a son, despite their advanced age and her barrenness. Sarai is thinking God needs help! Let’s be reasonable about this gynecological problem. So, Sarai considers her Egyptian maid and puts a spiritual gloss on it. She says to Abram, “The Lord has prevented me from having children.” Gen.16:2,3, (her phraseology betrays her self-serving quote.) “It may be that I shall obtain children by her.” Any time you try a hybrid, it cannot produce any good results. It sounded spiritual, so she suggested he take Hagar, the servant girl, as wife in order to have a child. Scripture says, “And Abram listened to his wife”. This is a rerun of Gen.3:17, “And Adam, be-

cause you've listened to your wife, cursed is the ground!" What? you mean the ground is not going to be fruitful to me anymore? All because of Eve offering her husband the fruit which God said, "No!" (Notice the serpent, the enemy, appears as foreign genetic material that causes hybrid results, even generational causalities.) Sarai was moved by calculation of hope to be built up by the child: after all, I can't, but he can and she can. Anyway, what can possibly go wrong? (my words) But when Hagar got pregnant, she despised Sarai. Desiring a child and being fruitful is part of the creation model. She thought Hagar would be a sort of surrogate and everything would be alright. The point of this article is now showing that even as far back as Abram, that when we "mix and match" God's word for us and skew it through doing our own thing, we dilute or even make sterile our fruit to reproduce. Even Solomon, who saw God's glory twice, mixed seed and created a kingdom of peace by marrying princesses. No kingly father would want to attack a kingdom where his daughter is a princess. But after 700 wives and 300 concubines later, we hear the voices of Solomon's vices turn his heart from God to idols through pride. Someone did not stay attached to the Vine, or to the de-vine, and his end was not well.

Harkening back to the birth of the mule, that mixing seed produced, even Abraham asked God if Ishmael could be the one, and God told him no. Isaac was the son of promise, the fruitful plan of God. Notice in Gen 16:12, several translations describe Ishmael as a "wild ass." Does that sound familiar to our title? Now, how about the headlines and news reports of the two nations these two men represent? How's that working out for us now? Stay in the Vine and be fruitful for Christ! Blessings.

Transitioning Into Kingdom Age - Theology



I first wrote a blog in 2014 called the shift from church age to kingdom age which is still the highest read blog monthly since I posted it. I wanted to touch on this again and may write a series of blogs on it. We indeed are shifting and seeing this shift underway. So, I hope this gives us some insight into what is going on.

The first and primary shift is a theological shift. This has to occur before any other shifts occur. We are seeing not a shift away from theology but more so an in-depth dive into true theology. We are seeing many searching out the deep things of God and the hidden mysteries. We are not looking through denomination eyes but through kingdom perspectives. We are re-evaluating what we felt was primary truth and concluding it was support truth. The primary at this time is the kingdom of God.



One of the theological shifts is actually understanding this truth of the kingdom not just through intellectual understanding of principles and promise we operate or believe. But it is also spiritual understanding of those same principles and promise with one more added dimension, protocols. We are becoming more aware of our spiritual reality that it is more than an add-on to our humanity, but our humanity is only the container for our spirit man. This means we are seeing how the kingdom and spiritual spheres operate (protocols). We are seeing things through eternal eyes and also kingdom language more than Greek or Hebrew.

As kingdom theology has come so has spiritual principles and protocols of how to function and function effectively. We have seen training and equipping not so much in proper exegesis and language understanding but in revelation and application. The Body of Christ has moved from being consumers to investors. Some have taken ownership of vision and mission. Others support it because of kingdom purposes. These are all parts of shifting from church age to kingdom age. We are more concerned about others than ourselves. We see services as times to equip more so than meet my need. Overall, this makes the Body healthy and to have a healthy perspective. We are actually bringing life back into daily areas once reserved for what revivals would do.

A kingdom of God perspective or focus brings greater clarity to the interpretation of the scriptures and a wider scope of understanding. We are not taking scripture out of context which happens many times in a church setting by taking the pastoral part and leaving the apostolic or kingdom part as not important. We are maturing into wanting the full counsel of God and the full application of the context of scripture. This means every scripture is a gateway to a vast mystery of God that has been hidden but now is being revealed. We are actually beginning to re-find what the ancient fathers knew.

This theological shift is causing us to look again at eschatology and ecclesiology. These both have shifted in the last ten years to a kingdom theology redefining both. We are not looking at escaping but looking at overcoming. We also don't see the church as a club or religious expression but as an army that is alive and trained to govern. These two things have shifted the function of the Body of

Christ into activation and participation instead of being spectators. This is the second shift which has a function.

This has also brought forth identity and purpose in many. Many are seeing how they are designed and what they are designed for. Finding their place, we see a lot of new ministries formed that are non-traditional. Creatives are finding their place of expression as well. People are becoming content with who and how God made them to be. Yes there is still striving and comparing, because of human nature and unredeemed areas, but I see a unique church arising that is creating a non- traditional expression.

Kingdom theology has also opened up the area of creativity in books and publishing. We have moved from self-help guides to eternal perspectives bringing a seriousness of purpose upon the body of Christ. Since the kingdom is so vast the need to understand it so great, there is much being produced to bring clarity in the area of published writing, blogs, podcast and a host of other avenues to reach a larger audience.

Kingdom theology also has begun to connect us as a singular Body of Christ verses a disjointed body. Kingdom principles have shifted our values and focuses. We are beginning to cross pollinate better, yet we still lack allowing the five-fold graces to cross pollinate, specifically apostles and prophets. We see there is more than a promise to stand on for what we need. We see kingdom principles of how to work those promises with faith to see outcome. This is not just affecting our personal lives but is starting to shift cities, states and even nations.

These are all some insights into things to shift into, if you haven't already. If you have shifted into these things then you need to steward to see fullness come. There is an ever-expanding understanding of this kingdom without end. It is now coming upon us and will continue to expand around and within us. Now is the time to either embark on a new journey of the kingdom or to enlarge what you have already experienced.

I was reading some of the remembrances/testimonies that have been shared with us after ministry of word of knowledge or prayer. It was thrilling to recall **WHAT THE LORD HAS DONE!** To God Jehovah Almighty be all the glory, great things He has done! Here are just a few, out of a long list of the workings of the Hand of Yahweh through Jesus Christ our Lord. Let them encourage you to call upon the Lord.

Ps.103:1-5,ESV—"Bless the Lord, O my soul, and all that is within me, bless his holy name! 2 Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits, 3 who forgives all your iniquity, who heals all your diseases, 4 who redeems your life from the pit, who crowns you with steadfast love and mercy, 5 who satisfies you with good so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's."

1.) One of our intercessors works for a large company that was bought out. She is 70 years old and has been in a fairly high position in that company. Last week, it appeared that she no longer had a job. BUT she is a woman of faith and prayer and tithing. Today she was **PROMOTED** and given an **INCREASE** in salary!! PTL!! A couple months ago the Lord told me "you haven't seen everything." Amen and, boy, am I looking forward to seeing more!!

2.) That intercessor's daughter was diagnosed with melanoma can-

cer on her back last month. Kathy, Melissa and I laid hands on her and declared the word of the Lord over her (along with her parents) for healing. While we were praying I had a vision of a hand hanging up an old phone receiver and, in my spirit, I heard the Lord say, "And that is the final word on the subject." They did surgery and this past Friday she went back to the Dr. The Dr. told her that she is cancer free!

3.) We ministered at a regional monthly meeting where several churches come together. As I was ministering some words of knowledge, I said something about "God is setting you free to run like a horse let out of the stall." A woman at the back hollered out and began to weep openly. She told me afterwards that just that day she had prayed, "Lord, can't you just set me free so that I can run like a horse let out of the stall?" She was still quite excited after the meeting. Father being that personal with her really blessed her.

4.) Another lady walked up afterward and was so excited. One of the words of knowledge was about lumps, bumps, growths, etc. She said that just that day she had asked the Lord how to pray about a lump she had. She asked in prayer, "Do I call it a lump, a bump or a growth?"--the very same words that were in the word of knowledge. She was almost jumping up and down, she was so excited.

5.) I had a word of knowledge about a kidney problem. As I gave the word, a woman yelled out. (There have been a number of instances of people yelling out when they have been healed.) At the moment I gave the word of knowledge, the woman was in pain from a long-time kidney problem. She yelled out because the pain suddenly stopped and it was such a change that it startled her.

6.) At lunch (at the church we ministered at one Sunday), a lady was sitting next to her daughter that she had been at odds with. They had not spoken or seen each other in a while except to argue. The church lunch turned into a ministry time to them and their relationship was reconciled during lunch!

7.) A lady (in her 40's) who felt she was supposed to go to college had planned on going in the city she was visiting from. After lunch she told the pastor she believed the Lord wants her to move to his city and go to school there and go to his church.

8.) At the same church, a young man received prophecy who was a practicing homosexual. His countenance immediately changed. At the end of the service he prayed for a man to be healed. The next day the pastor said that he had not seen him ever look that manly as when he left that afternoon after lunch. I can witness that he looked, and acted, completely different.

9.) It seems that the number 20 has been significant in the last couple of years. Near the end of last year Kathy received a word from the Lord about the number 20. She says, “It is the biblical number for expectancy, the kind of expectancy that comes at the point when battles are finally won or preparation finally brings results or the point when process yields fruit or the point when equipping fulfills its purpose. I believe the “20” in this year re-emphasizes the focus on an expectation to see and walk in different results.”

A couple of weeks ago I received a call from a pastor in England. I prophesied to them at the Gathering of Eagles on Lake Conroe about 20 years ago. I saw 2 buildings the Lord would provide for their church. They were not to worry about money because God had already provided. The prophecy described the buildings and the property layout. They hung on to that word for years (since the Gathering of Eagles) and were considering it was getting on to time to retire. It was beginning to look like the word would never come to pass. They had planned to go to Romania on a missions trip but felt they should cancel. The pastor received a phone call during the time he would have been in Romania about a building for their church. It had already been offered to two other groups.

When he called, the lady helping with the property said she had just prayed about the building a few minutes before he called and she prayed the exact things that the pastor said to her in their hour-long conversation. He was instructed to call the bishop over that property. He talked to the bishop and, after a brief conversation, the bishop asked when they wanted to move in. All they had to do was just keep up the property and after a few months, the bishop would simply transfer the property to them.

The two buildings described in the prophecy are on that property. The second building is a school-like building which was de-

scribed in the prophecy. They had been praying for one to use as a training center. There is a Nepalese community in the area and some people from Nepal are already attending. The church has been helping their sons who are on drugs and helped them get into Teen Challenge. They need the school building for discipleship training.

10.) In another meeting I prophesied to a man that God was going to fulfill a promise He made to him 20 yrs. ago. He told me afterward that he thought I was crazy. He said he couldn't even remember 20 days ago, let alone 20 years ago. But as he was leaving the house on the way to the meeting, he couldn't find his regular Bible he always took to church. He grabbed an old one off the shelf on the way out the door. When he went back to his seat, after being prophesied to, he opened that Bible and there was a dated note he had written 20 years ago of a promise God gave him. The date on the note was written 20 years ago that week.

When in Oklahoma I felt it urgent that I share the word about the number 20 with them. Unknown to me, they were celebrating their 20th Anniversary as a church the following week and received confirmation for direction from the Lord that day.

It was after 20 years that Jacob received his wives and possessions. Israel had been under the domination of the Philistines for 20 years when Samson was born. God does bring processes to an end and cause them to yield fruit.

We pray for you that your expectancy in the remainder of this year will see battles finally won, preparation finally bringing results, process yielding fruit and equipping fulfilling its purpose.

May this year look totally different as you look back on it than any year prior has looked. May you say that it had the look of answers, resolve and fulfillment.

“From now on I'm the one who answers and satisfies him. I am like a luxuriant fruit tree. Everything you need is to be found in me.” (Hos.14:8b, Msg)

11.) We ministered at a church in the Houston area. It is a multinational church consisting of people from eight nations. The

service is bi-lingual. When we were there a few months ago I had several words of knowledge. Three of the words were about major physical problems. The pastor's wife (she is co-pastor) had all three. She had been to several specialists about the problems and was told that she needed surgery. She came down off the platform and stood to receive the word for her healing.

A few weeks after the word of knowledge, she went to the doctor who had told her she must have surgery. He wanted to do a few more tests before scheduling her for surgery. When the test results came in, he told her she did not need surgery. That was a couple of months ago and she was doing great and having no problems Sunday. She interpreted for me as I preached Sunday.

12.) Also, on that same Sunday a few months ago, one of the words was about women who wanted to have a baby but were not able. They announced this past Sunday that those three women are now expecting and there was great joy among the people.

13.) In the service Sunday a lady came up afterwards and was very excited and told me in broken English that her neck and spine were healed in the meeting and she was rejoicing that she was totally without pain.

14.) The next day I received a message on FaceBook from a lady who was unable to be in the service. She watched the service on YouTube Monday morning and wrote a comment under the picture of the worship service that I posted during the meeting. She does not speak English very well but she said, "Yesterday, I couldn't go to the service but this morning I saw you by internet and you made my day so happy. Thanks God for your beautiful words."

15.) At the altar call about 50 people came forward wanting to confess that they had not been living like Jesus is Lord of their life but that they intended to live in obedience to His Word from now on. We were with the pastors until almost 5:00pm encouraging them and their family and declaring to them as the Lord gave words through us. They shared with us how others had been blessed and changed by the Word of the Lord from our ministering there in previous meetings the year before.

16.) We ministered at one church two Sundays in a row. Kathy spoke one Sunday and I the next. The first Sunday I had a word of knowledge about the Lord healing tissues and sinuses. The next Sunday a lady walked up who was very excited. She had been having problems with the tissues in her sinuses and had not been able to breathe out of her left nostril for sometime. She testified that the tissues in her sinuses had not given her any more problems and she is now able to breathe freely through her left nostril. I don't blame her for her excitement. The Lord is so good!

17.) Awhile back in a church we ministered in in Texas, one of their leaders was up over the auditorium in the attic working on a project. He fell through the ceiling for 20 feet and landed on his head. When the pastor found him, he had been lying on the floor for twenty minutes and blood was coming out of his ears. He was life-flighted to the hospital in another city. After examination, the doctor told his wife that he would not live. Kathy sent her a prophetic word the Lord had given her. The wife went into the critical care unit and whispered it into his ear. A few days later, the doctor told the wife that if he lived he wouldn't be able to function normally. The following Monday he went back to work! The company he works for sells equipment to brain surgeons. This man flies all over the nation and trains brain surgeons how to use the equipment they need during brain surgery!

A few weeks later, I prophesied to him about the new that is coming with several descriptive details. He and his wife were very excited during the prophecy. He told me after service that he had dreamed those details two nights before I prophesied them and was very uplifted about the new the Lord was bringing and is eagerly going into the future the Lord has planned.

18.) The pastor of a church in a city many miles away, whom we have know a long time, had a heart attack. They rushed him to the hospital. His daughter called at 11:30pm quite hysterical. Kathy and I began to pray and make declarations over the pastor. Upon examination, they told his wife there was nothing they could do for him at that hospital and that he should immediately be transferred to another hospital. While they were loading the pastor into the ambulance, the doctor told the wife she should ride in the ambulance with her husband because he probably would not be alive when they arrived at the hospital. Two days later he walked out of the hospital! The wife works at the first hospital they took him to. Regularly, people walk up to her and ask how "the miracle man" is doing. Bless the Lord! 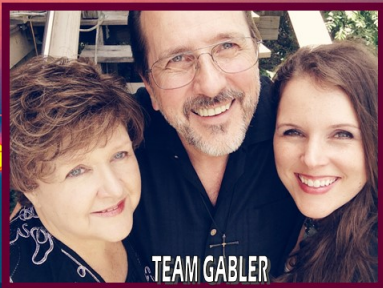
